## Daily Living Skills

Learn a broad range of individualized tips, techniques and use of assistive devices for clothing management, cooking, operating household appliances, cleaning, and money identification.

## Communication Skills

Learn adaptive skills to help with writing, using a telephone, tactile labeling, and navigating the internet.

## Orientation & Mobility

Learn to move about your home and/or community safely.
